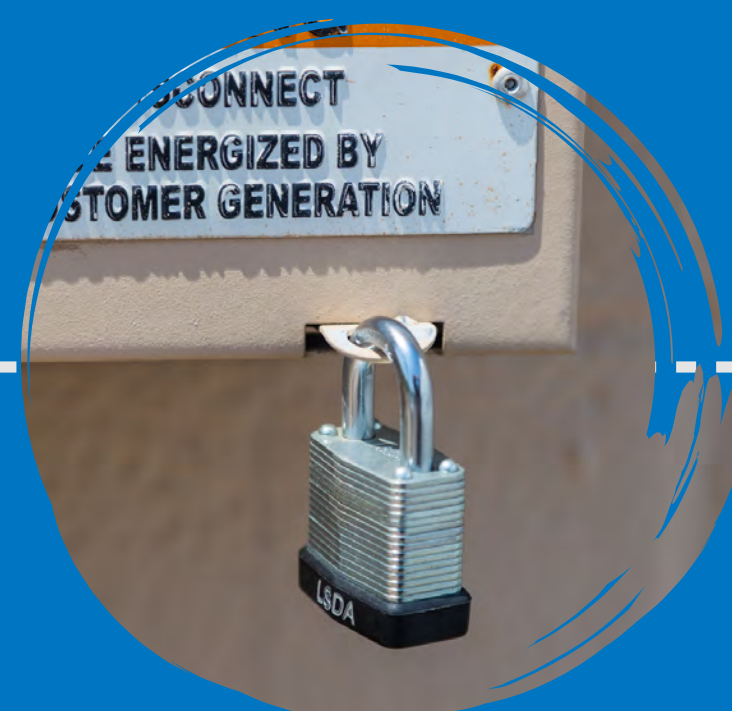


How Do I Turn On My Solar Electric System?



Confirm your system has been inspected by the utility. You'll see a new solar meter for most utilities, or a "Cogeneration" sticker for SSVEC.



Install the supplied lock on your PV AC Disconnect (it will be inside the disconnect)



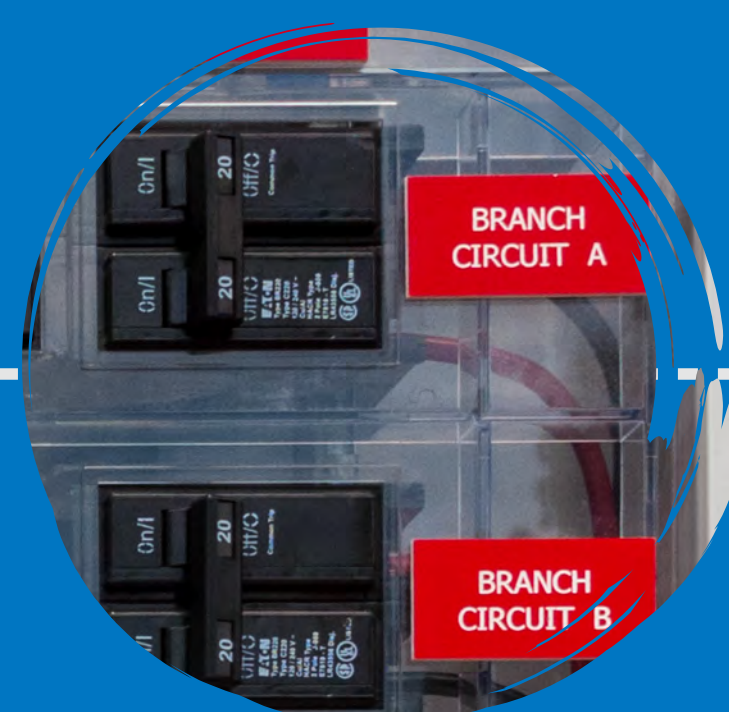
Turn on the solar breaker in your main load center.



Turn on your PV AC Disconnect using the large handle on the right.



Inside your combiner (large gray box), turn on your Envoy solar monitoring device by pushing the breaker toward the middle.



Inside your combiner, turn on your solar branch circuit breakers (as many as four) by pushing them toward the middle.



Wait five minutes for the system to monitor the grid, then automatically start up!



Make clean energy! Scrolling bars on the solar meter mean your system is up and running.
